RE. COVID-19 Update for Parents – School Events/Calendar Revisions

Firstly, thanks to all families for their on-going patience and support at this challenging time nationally. Teams across the school have been **exemplary** in coming together to support. I have clarity from Stirling Council regarding a number of key points concerning planned school events and will update parents on an on-going basis as and when relevant information is received. Key updates that currently affect the school calendar/planned events are as follows:

- 1. **S2 Parents' Evening** has now been postponed. Depending on the national situation, we will look to agree a date in the summer term to hold this so that parents still receive feedback.
- 2. Thursday's PTN meeting has been cancelled.
- 3. There is a 'pause' on all **primary transition** events.
- 4. The Creative Industries Spring Showcase has been cancelled.
- 5. Easter Assemblies have been cancelled.
- 6. There will be an update by the end of the week regarding the **S6 Graduation** and day away. Both are scheduled for the first week back after Easter.
- 7. **Foreign trips** the Scottish Government has indicated that there should be no school trips abroad at this time. We are awaiting clarity on a confirmed timescale for this and insurance arrangements regarding parental refunds before confirming cancellation.
- 8. Due to the volume of preparation and uncertainty regarding bookings and tour providers, **Activities Day** will be cancelled this year. We will resume next session.
- 9. Non-urgent **TAC** meetings will be postponed. We will seek to communicate any key information as a supportive measure by telephone call until we can resume meetings.

Thanks again to families for their support and understanding in the midst of this developing situation. I anticipate things continuing to evolve in the days and weeks ahead and we will respond to information and advice as we receive it in as timeous, calm and sensitive a manner as possible. Any parent/carer with a personalised concern about their child's health and wellbeing should continue to follow NHS advice.
