Key Information for Pupils and Parents/Carers

- Year groups will be split into thirds and come into school to follow their normal timetable on the days noted above.
- Pupil lists for each day will be posted on year group Google Classrooms and parents/carers will receive individual texts, by the end of Thursday 11th, in order to confirm the core days their child will be expected to attend for this period.
- Pupils should attend school as normal on their allocated days in full school uniform.
 Pupils should bring a face covering as face coverings should be worn, according to government guidance, by all pupils from \$1-6 in the school building, throughout the school day (except for the small number of pupils who are exempt).
- If a pupil has PE on their timetabled day, they should bring PE kit as we will have outside PE activities taking place.
- For any S5/6 scheduled to come in on a Monday or Tuesday, your day will start at 10.00, as per the pre-lockdown period. Your core HWB periods will return when we have wider functionality for PE.
- School of Sport will resume post-Easter in terms of physical activity in school. We will continue our online challenges and engagement for School of Sport pupils until then.
- Additional invitations to seniors for targeted work will be sent directly to them by teaching staff through Google communication channels.
- The above allows for **mandatory 2m distancing indoors**, meets Fallin bus capacity requirements, and prioritises more time for senior pupils, including targeted inputs, whilst ensuring that *all* pupils have **at least two full days** in school prior to the break.
- Break and lunch times will be split according to existing timetable arrangements and lunch delivery will be on offer to classroom spaces to support distancing, whilst pupils will be allowed outside at lunchtime and breaktime, with distancing strongly encouraged. Pupils who wish to order a lunch for any given day will be provided with an order form during period 1 and this will be delivered prior to lunch. There will be a break service available, but pupils will be required to queue individually with 2m distancing for this.
- The **Atrium will be for transition only** during the day and pupils will be encouraged outdoors for safe distancing and airflow.

- Any pupils who access the community at lunchtime should be mindful of **distancing** and **face covering requirements** in local establishments.
- We will stagger entry and exit to the building to support distancing at transition points. We will use wing entry and exit points for each faculty and direct pupils towards class areas from 08.45 in order to minimise volume moving at any one time. We will Tannoy a slightly staggered departure at the end of the day.
- Key to all of this is the opportunity to re-connect pupils and staff physically and socially with school and for us to sustain blended learning and quality delivery to the majority of pupils, who will continue to learn from home throughout this period.
- Pupil Lateral Flow Tests will be available for collection for any S4/5/6 who are coming on Monday Wednesday in week one from the School Office on Thursday 11th and Friday 12th March from 12.00-15.00, or on attendance at school on Monday 15th. These tests are not mandatory but are strongly encouraged by the Scottish Government.
- Our **Ochil House** provision will continue to be fully operational as normal.
- Our Key Worker Hub will continue as normal throughout this period. Pupils who
 access the Hub should come to their allocated space, as normal, each day. On the
 days when they have been allocated to a wider school group, they should follow
 their normal timetable that day and return to the Hub for any other days.
- School transport will operate as normal. Please see the attached transport FAQs,
 which should cover any transport enquiries that you have. It is important that pupils
 note that face coverings (unless exempt) should be worn on transport at all times
 and that pupils will be required to sit in single seats, distanced as per the driver's
 instructions.
- A full return to provision for all students is currently scheduled for Monday 19th
 April. Any necessary updated guidance will follow.
