This means considering your course options by taking fully into account your strongest subjects and those you enjoy and work hardest in.

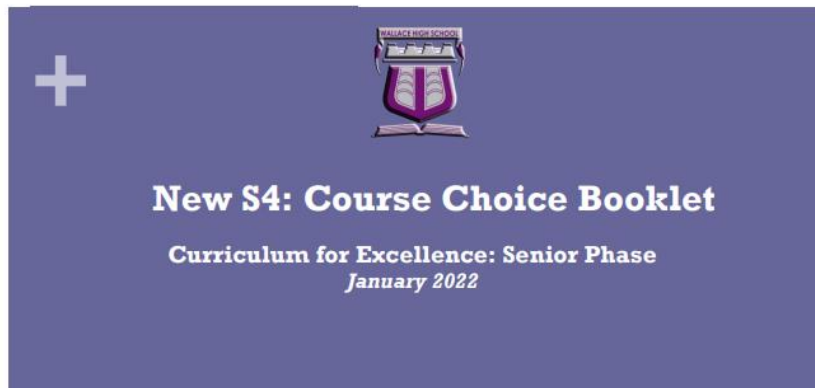
You have had lots of feedback on this in your first three years in school and so you should have a good idea of your strongest areas and those that you, broadly, wish to continue to study.

S4 OPTIONS

S4 2022/23

- ◉ 7 full subject courses
- ◉ 4 periods each + 2 x core PE + 1 x core RMPS + 1 x flexible study support/HWB
- ◉ English, Maths and five 'open' options
- ◉ Encourage breadth but the OPTION for specialism and focus is there
- ◉ There are a range of college options for pupils - please discuss with Pupil Support
- ◉ All pupils must choose one back-up option in case a subject is over-subscribed

- ◉ We attempt to provide an ‘open’ choice to ensure that we maximise choice of subjects that will lead to success
- ◉ S3 Pupil Support/Careers interviews have included conversations to support the **BEST** choices being made and an additional parental/pupil meeting (via Google Meet) can be requested
- ◉ Even if pupils and parents feel they do not require an additional meeting following completing the online form, all forms will be reviewed by the Pupil Support team and we will discuss any issues that arise from this by contacting you (ensuring that we have considered, collectively, the **best** options for your child).
- ◉ Where staffing/demand limits a choice in any subject we will discuss this and seek to ensure there is a good alternative choice


WHAT CHOICES?

- ◉ University/college entrance qualifications?
- ◉ Maximise **your** skills
- ◉ Plan courses over **3 years (think S4 & S5 into S6)**
- ◉ Are any subjects required for your chosen/ possible career?
- ◉ Advice from: Pupil Support Leader/ Subject Specialists/ Careers (SDS)/ My World of Work...don't be afraid to ask your teachers lots of questions about this via Google Classroom
