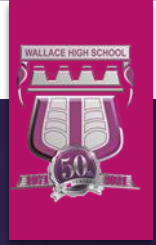




School Uniform Expectations 2023



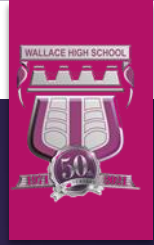
What To Wear...

All Pupils

- ▶ White school shirt
- ▶ Black trousers or skirt
- ▶ School tie
- ▶ Blazer (see notes in next column)
- ▶ Plain black footwear (preferably school shoes; not branded trainers)
- ▶ Wallace PE kit
- ▶ Plain black jumper or cardigan

Year Group Specific

- ▶ **S1-3:** Pupils should come in S1 with a blazer. We *encourage* this for S2/3, where this can be maintained, but accept cost to replace can be a barrier, so compromise as pupils grow throughout S2/3.
- ▶ **S4-6:** Braided senior blazer is compulsory for all S4-6 pupils, alongside their senior tie.
- ▶ Please note: support is available regarding borrowing blazers



What Not To Wear...

All Pupils

- ▶ Hooded tops and branded, labelled jumpers should come off in the school building.
- ▶ Denims and tracksuit bottoms are not appropriate for school.
- ▶ Expensive labelled trainers or Converse-style white trainers are prohibited. As long as footwear is **plain black**, there is no issue.
- ▶ Baseball caps are not allowed in school.

Rationale

- ▶ **Equity** – we are a large, diverse community and we don't want any pupils to feel under pressure because of expensive labels etc. We also want **all** pupils to **look smart and professional**.
 - ▶ We issue every pupil with a tie. Shirts, trousers/skirts, footwear and plain jumpers can all be purchased in supermarkets or online at reasonable prices.
 - ▶ Blazers are our one more costly item and we can support where families have difficulty as can our excellent PTN Uniform Bank.
