

ENTRY TO COURSES

 NATIONAL 5 (SCQF 5) courses are designed to follow on from National 4 (SCQF 4)

 HIGHER (SCQF 6) courses are designed to follow on from National 5 (SCQF 5)

 ADVANCED HIGHER (SCQF 7) courses are designed to follow on from Higher (SCQF 6)



- We attempt to provide a structure that ensures that we maximise access to first choice subjects
- Interviews are designed to support rigour when choosing to ensure the BEST choices are being made
- Where staffing/demand limits a choice in any subject we will discuss this and seek to ensure this is achievable over S5/6
- Advanced Higher period allocation and range depends on uptake

Qualifications by the end of S5



University of Strathclyde

Degree: e.g. BA Hons Entry: <u>Minimum</u> 4 Highers + Nat 5 English and Maths

University of Stirling

Degree: BSc Aqualculture

Entry: Highers BBBB. One of Biology, Chemistry, Human Biology and Maths or Physics (B). Nat 5 Maths

Degree: BSc Ecology

Entry: Highers BBBB. One of Human Biology, Biology and Maths or Physics (B). Nat 5 English

University of Aberdeen

Degree: Chemical Engineering BEng / Mechanical Engineering Beng Entry: Highers BBBB. (B) in Maths and in Physics and/or Technological Studies (B). Nat 5 English

Degree: History BA / Management Science BA

Entry: Highers BBBB. Nat 5 English (minimum)

University of Glasgow

Degree: Mechanical Engineering BEng / Civil Engineering BEng Entry: Highers AAAAA in first sitting, including Maths and Physics

Degree: Veterinary Medicine and Surgery BVM&S Entry: Highers AAAAA first sitting including Chemistry, Biology and either Physics or Mathematics. Chemistry (A) expected. Advanced Highers BB in Chemistry and Biology.

Degree: Business Economics MA (SocSci) Entry: Highers AAAA first sitting.

Qualifications by the end of \$5



University of Edinburgh

Degree: Electrical and Mechanical Engineering BEng Entry: Highers AAAA–ABBB. Include Maths (A), plus Physics (preferably), Engineering or Technological Studies. Nat 5 English.

Degree: Business and Accountancy Entry: Highers BBBB. Maths strongly preferred. Nat 5 Maths and English.

Degree: Scottish History MA Entry: Highers BBB. Nat 5 English. Maths or an approved Science at Nat 5.

Degree: Medicine MBChB Entry: Highers AAAAA to include Chemistry and two of Biology, Mathematics or Physics. Missing Science can be taken in S6. Human Biology can replace Biology. Nat 5 Biology, Chemistry, English and Maths.

Queen Margaret University College

Degree: Physiotherapy BSc Hons Entry: Highers AAAAA or 355 UCAS points

Degree: Applied Pharmacology BSc Hons Entry: Highers BCC or 165 UCAS points

Degree: Business Management BA/BA Hons Entry: Highers BBB or 195 UCAS points

Degree: Podiatry BSc/BSc Hons Entry: Highers BBBC or 245 UCAS points



Qualifications by the end of S5

Examples of University Requirements

University of Aberdeen Statement on National 5 Qualifications is fairly typical:

"The University of Aberdeen currently <u>does not</u> stipulate a minimum number of National 5 subjects.

We <u>do not</u> use the overall number of National 5 qualifications achieved to determine suitability.

<u>There is a requirement to hold minimum qualifications in particular subjects</u>, such as English and Maths, as detailed below.

National 5 in grade C or above is required as follows:

MA and Divinity – English for all degrees; Maths for degrees involving Accountancy, Economics or Finance.

Law – English

Science – English and Maths, plus either Chemistry or Physics

Engineering – English

Primary Education – Maths - Standard Grade 2 or above, Intermediate 2, Grade C or above. National 5 grade still to be set by Scottish Executive Education Department.
